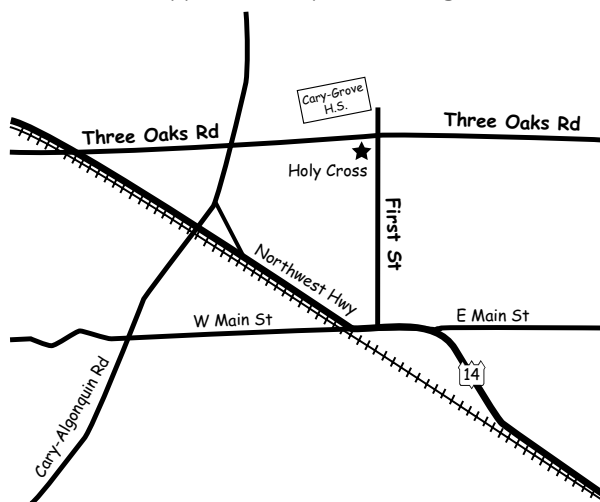

PURPOSE

Holy Cross Lutheran Preschool & Kindergarten was established as a Christian Outreach to the congregation and to the community. Our primary purpose is to provide quality Christian education for children and their families. We desire to witness Christ's love and forgiveness.

PHILOSOPHY

ENROLLMENT/ADMISSIONS POLICIES

ADMISSION AGE REQUIREMENT

Holy Cross Lutheran Preschool & Kindergarten admits children that have attained the age of three, four, or five (depending on the program chosen) by September 1st of the current school year.

ADMISSION PREFERENCE PROCEDURE

Children are enrolled in the following preference order:

1. Children who are presently enrolled, or who have been previously enrolled, in Holy Cross Lutheran Preschool & Kindergarten.
2. Children of parents who are members of Holy Cross Lutheran Church.
3. Children in the community.



Registration is ongoing until all classes are filled. Enrollment open to the community begins Monday, February 1, 2010.
