## FROM PASTOR'S DESK

## "Does God Hate Religion?"

I've lost track of the times I've heard someone say, "God hates religion". It's a very common claim among modern-day Christians. The argument usually goes something along the lines of saying how God hates religion, usually defined as a list of rules and commands to follow, and is much more interested in a personal relationship with people. But is this claim true? Does God actually hate religion?

First, let's define the term. Religion is, "a personal set or institutionalized system of religious attitudes, beliefs, and practices" (Merriam-Webster). Does God hate having a system of religious attitudes, beliefs, and practices? No. In fact, he instituted a religion himself: Christianity.

After God created Adam, he gave him a command: don't eat the forbidden fruit! Adam was to believe God's Word and practice obedience to him. Later in history, God gave the Israelites the 10 Commandments, a list of laws they were to follow, and others which would form their attitudes, beliefs, and practices. This is the law of God. And what does Scripture say about God's Law? "So the law is holy, and the commandment is holy and righteous and good" (Romans 7:12). "The law of the Lord is perfect, reviving the soul..." (Psalm 19:7). "For this is the love of God, that we keep his commandments. And his commandments are not burdensome" (1 John 5:3). "Do not think that I have come to abolish the Law or the Prophets; I have not come to abolish them but to fulfill them" (Matthew 5:17). Apparently, it's not sinful to have a system of religious attitudes, beliefs, and practices: a religion. So what does God hate?

God hates false religion or man-made religion. He hates that which has not come from him nor points to him. "The prophets are prophesying lies in my name. I did not send them, nor did I command them or speak to them. They are prophesying to you a lying vision, worthless divination, and the deceit of their own minds" (Jeremiah 14:14). "But that prophet or that dreamer of dreams shall be put to death, because he has counseled rebellion against the Lord your God..." (Deuteronomy 13:5). "Beware of false prophets, who come to you in sheep's clothing but inwardly are ravenous wolves" (Matthew 7:15). This is why Jesus chastised the Pharisees, for they spoke lies in the name of God and burdened the people with things he did not command. "They tie up heavy burdens, hard to bear, and lay them on people's shoulders, but they themselves are not willing to move them with their finger" (Matthew 23:4). "Which of you, having a son or an ox that has fallen into a well on a Sabbath day, will not immediately pull him out?" (Luke 14:5).

Does God hate religion? No, not the one true religion of Christianity that he instituted. He does hate false religion, false doctrine, and false laws that do not come from him. So next time you hear someone say, "God's not about religion, but a personal relationship," you can say he is about religion, the one true religion of Christianity. But what about that personal relationship? Well, we'll save that can of worms for another Crosslink.
