

PRAYER SHAWL LWML

A. Ministry Purpose:

Prayer Shawl Ministry is an organization of the national LWML (Lutheran Women in Mission) that meets twice a month for Bible study and needlework. By collecting our mites (small monetary donations) we support the mission projects of the national and district LWML organization. Our Bible studies are often taken from Lutheran Women's Quarterly, the national LWML publication.

Our needlework provides shawls, lap robes, blankets, hats, scarfs and mittens to be given away to anyone in need of comfort or celebration of events in their lives. These items convey the warmth of God's love for each recipient. They are made and dedicated with prayer.

Prayer Shawl members gain knowledge and insight into God's Word through their studies.

C. Job Description:

Each participant joins in Bible study and enjoys needlework during the meetings and in their daily life.

D. Time Commitment:

Prayer Shawl LWML meetings are twice a month on the second and fourth Thursday mornings for about two hours. Needlework continues with each member on their own.

There is no set commitment to this ministry. You can be involved as your time and desire allows.

F. Training Provided:

Help with needlework projects is freely provided among participants.

G. Skills / Qualifications:

Novices and accomplished needle workers are all welcome.

Each participant enjoys fellowship and Christian growth through Bible study, district and national affiliation and needlework projects.
